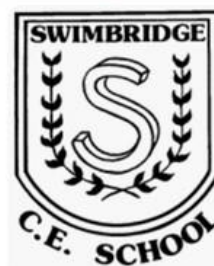

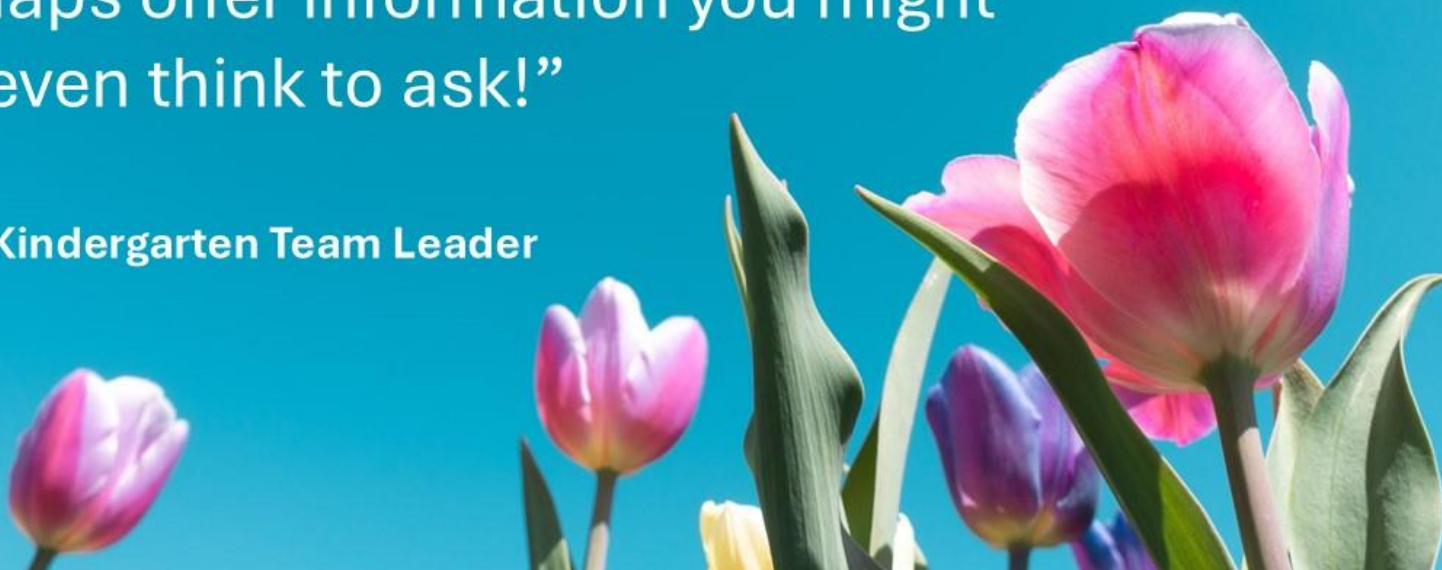

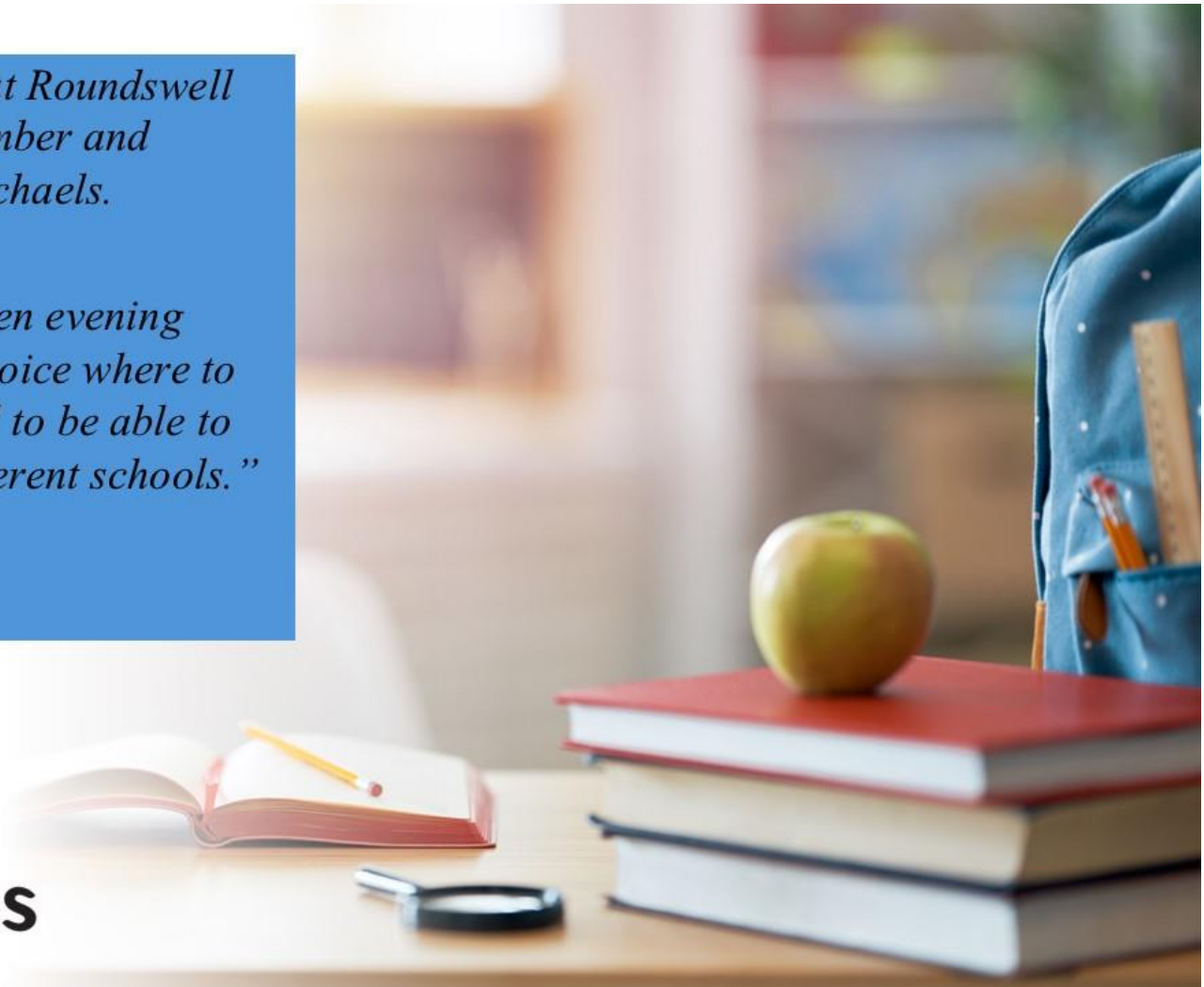
My daughter has started at Roundswell Primary school this September and previously attended St. Michaels.



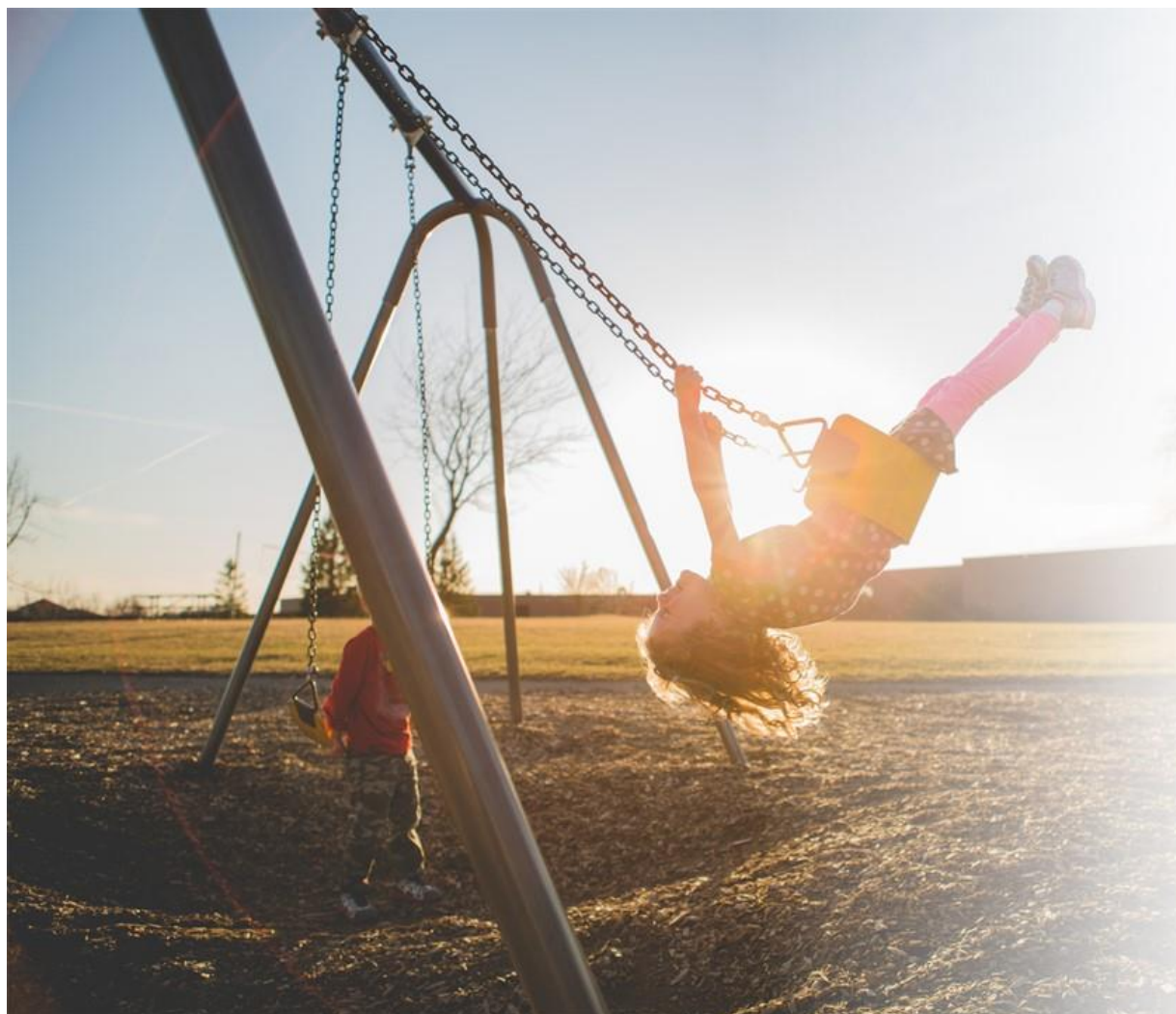
